Learning outcomes of the course unit:

Student is able to:

- use basic nursing techniques and nurse's interventions according to given rules
- apply basic knowledge and skills of nursing in the implementation of individual interventions
- collaborate with other members of multi-disciplinary team

Course contents:

- 1. Infusion, types of infusion appliances. Parenteral nutrition.
- 2. Transfusion, types of transfusion appliances. Checks of blood compatibility, documentation. Reaction after transfusion.
- 3. Collection of biological samples. General rules of collection of biological samples. Collection of blood, urine, faecal, and sputum.
- 4. Collection of biological samples. Swabs from nasal cavity, nasopharynx, amygdala, ear, conjunctival sac, rectum, and wounds
- 5. Asepsis, antisepsis, hygiene-epidemiologic mode, decontamination, cleaning, disinfection, disinsectization, deratization, sterilisation. Tool maintenance.
- 6. Barrier nursing technique (PPE, hand hygiene, hygienic hand disinfection, decontamination). Personal protection equipment, working clothes. Hand hygiene, hygienic hand disinfection.
- 7. Specifics barrier nursing techniques in selected workplaces / nursing units.
- 8. Excursion to the selected department of FH Trencin.
- 9. Aseptic procedures training and assistance for selected surgical procedures. Mostly aseptic surgical wound. Preparing a sterile table. Removing stitches.
- 10. Aseptic procedures training and assistance in the treatment of septic wound.
- 11. Excursion to the surgical clinic of FH Trencin.

- 12. Aseptic procedures training and assistance in puncture. Types puncture indication.
- 13. Exercising practical skills.
